Creative & Performing Arts

Performing Arts offers professional training in acting while providing opportunities to work with industry practitioners. Graduates progress into theatre, film, voice acting, production and further study.

Our **Professional Floristry** course develops commercial and creative skills for careers in floral design, retail and events.

Advanced Art and Design, Advanced Fashion Design and Advanced Fashion Industry Practice all Level 6, prepare students for careers in visual art, design, styling, garment construction, retail and creative entrepreneurship.

Health, Fitness & Wellbeing

We offer two routes into **Yoga Teaching & Holistic Studies** – a part-time programme and a Back to Education Initiative (BTEI) option for eligible learners.

Our **Pilates Teacher Training** programme prepares learners to become confident, professional instructors, while our two Level 6 sports courses **Personal Training, Strength and Conditioning** and **Personal Training and Sports Rehabilitation** develop advanced knowledge for working as a personal trainer or careers in fitness, rehabilitation and exercise science.

Education, Childcare & Inclusion

Learners interested in education and care can progress through **Advanced Early Learning and Care** or **Advanced Special Needs Assisting and Play Therapy**, preparing for rewarding careers across childcare, education and healthcare settings such as play room leader or supervisor.

Social Care & Community Development

Our **Advanced Social Studies and Advocacy** programme equips graduates with the knowledge and practical skills to work in social care, advocacy and community development, sup-

porting individuals, families and communities.

Why Dublin College Sallynoggin?

Many programmes are delivered over three or four days each week, offering flexibility for adults balancing study with work or family commitments. Courses are practical, industry-focused and designed to develop skills employers value while also providing progression opportunities into higher education.
